They develop a positive attitude for learning, motivating them to develop connections between the theoretical concepts in the classroom and what has been experienced outside of it.

Internship	Experiential learning	An internship is a form of experiential learning that integrates knowledge and theory learned in the classroom with practical application and skills development in a professional setting. Students get the opportunity to gain valuable applied experience and make connections in professional fields they are considering for career paths. An internship engages students with hands-on experiences that enhance their learning or skills within their fields of study.
