Smt. S. Radhika, Vice Principal and Academic Coordinator, proposed a vote of thanks.




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### Training Programme on Virtual Classrooms for Lecturers of Government Degree Colleges

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
## Two-Day Training Programme for Non-Teaching Staff on CAIMS 19.07,2019 to 20,07,2019

The participants were given hands-on training in presentation techniques and were greatly benefited.



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
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# One Day Workshop on "Code Tantra" organized by Department of Computer Science
