The IQAC organized a programme on the *'Importance of Professional Ethics in GDCs'* on 11.01.2020. The Resource Persons were Dr. G. Yadagiri, Principal, Government Degree College (W), Begumpet, and Dr. Neeraja, Academic Officer, Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, T.S, Hyderabad.

The aim of the programme was to focus on the Professional Ethics that are required for a teacher in the current scenario. Dr. Yadagiri addressed the participants and focussed on the character traits that a teacher must have. He also spoke about the need for professional ethics such as confidentiality, integrity, fairness, respect, responsibility, etc. He also spoke about a professional code of conduct that requires a teacher to continue education and engage in educational research to continuously improve oneself.
