Feedback Analysis on Curriculum for the Academic Year 2016-17

On the basis of the analysis of the Student Feedback Report for the academic year 2016-17, the following steps have been taken.

Depth of the course content:

About 88 % of the student respondents (176 out of 200) were happy with the present CBCS curriculum and the courses offered in the college. It was resolved to adhere with the revised curriculum framed by Affiliating University.

Applicability/ relevance to real life situations:

As 86 % of the students (172 out of 200) were of the opinion that the present curriculum was helpful in finding employment and also caters to the needs of the society. To satisfy the remaining 14% of the students (28 out of 200), it was resolved to focus on introducing the courses which have a potential to provide employment. For this, the TSKC (Telangana Skills and Knowledge Centre) of the college is to be strengthened further with a special focus on employability skills and encourage students to enroll in TSKC.

Learning values:

95% of the student respondents (190 of 200) felt that the present curriculum was conducive to help them groom themselves to their satisfactory levels. The introduction of semester system helps students to acquire in-depth knowledge which enables them to master the subject. However the opinion of the remaining 5% of students was considered and it was resolved to benefit these students by arranging special classes.

Clarity and relevance:

With the introduction of semester system the syllabus is designed in such a way that it helps student to gain thorough knowledge of the subject. 178 out of 200 students, i.e., 89% of the students opined that the present curriculum designed semester-wise helps them to get clarity on the subject. To satisfy the remaining 11% of the students, it was resolved to introduce peer teaching methods.

Relevance of additional course material:

172 out of 200 respondents (86%) were satisfied with course content and the study material in the college which includes the recent developments in it. 28 students (14%) appealed for additional supplementary course material to intensify their learning standards.
