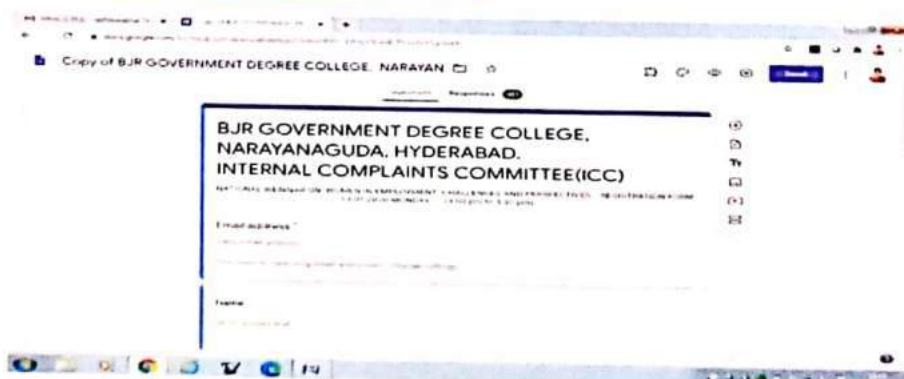
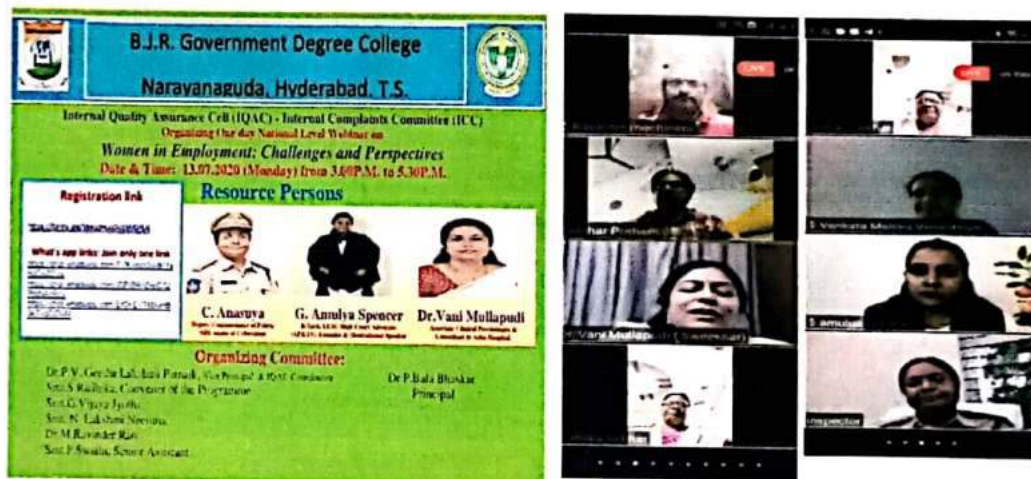

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National Level Webinar on 'Women in Employment: Challenges and Perspectives'

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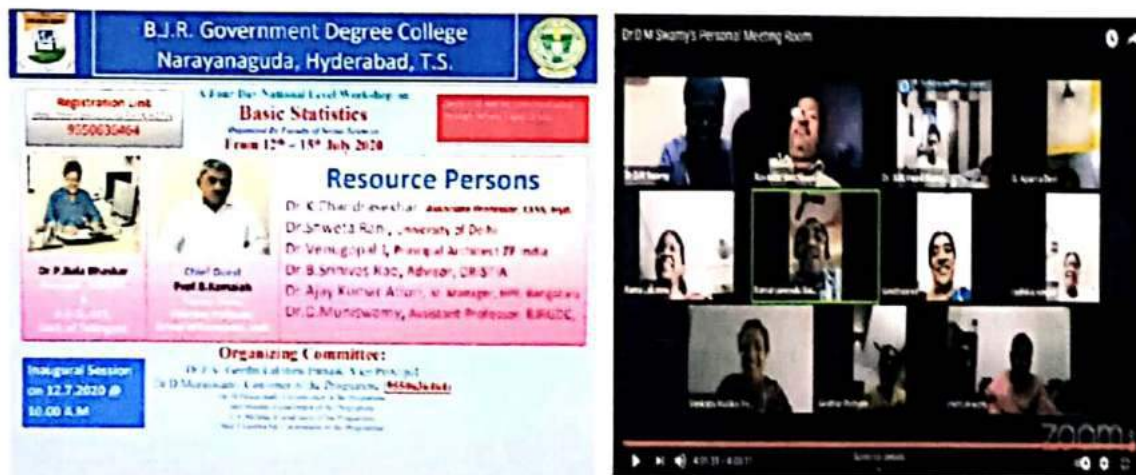
National Level Workshop on 'Basic Statistics' organized by the

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Webinar on *Unification of Forces* by Physics Department

12.05.2020

A webinar was organized by the Department Of Physics on the topic "*Unification of Forces*" for all B.Sc. Physics students on 12-05-2020. The Resource person for the lecture was Sri.K.Subba Rao, Department Of Physics, Sarojini Naidu Vanita Mahavidyalaya, Nampally, Hyderabad.

The webinar dealt with a detailed explanation of the four fundamental forces of nature: Gravitational forces, Electromagnetic forces, Strong nuclear forces, and Weak forces. The Resource Person presented a discussion on the Theories about Unification of forces- Spontaneous symmetry breaking, and explained how there is a speculation, that in the early Universe when temperatures are very high (Planck's scale) four forces are unified to a single force. As the temperatures dropped, gravitational forces separated from the three forces. With further decrease in temperature strong forces got separated first and at still lower temperatures the Electromagnetic and Weak forces are separated to leave with four distinct forces we experience in the present Universe. Grand Unified Theory (GUT) and Super Unified theories remain theoretical speculations and are yet unproven. There is a strong experimental evidence for unification of Electromagnetic and Weak interactions in the standard Electro weak Theory. Circumstantial evidence suggests that a GUT is required to make the sense of the Universe.

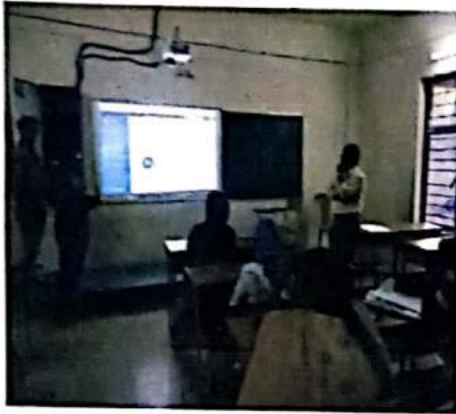

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Training Programme on Virtual Classrooms for Lecturers of Government Degree Colleges

The students were introduced to the new techniques of Student Centred Methodology and activities like pair work, group work etc were most popular among them. The teacher and students were able to benefit from the programme.




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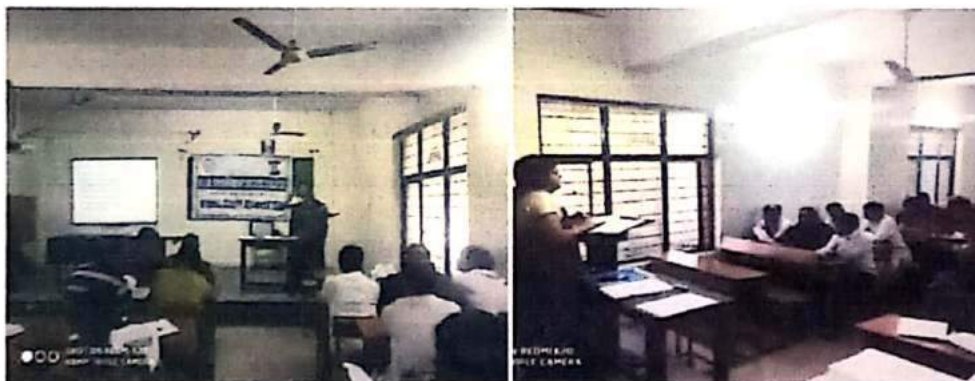
Orientation Programme/Workshop for Teaching Staff on 'Student-Centred Methodology and Learner Autonomy'

The workshop was successful in sensitizing the faculty towards the need for adapting to the paradigm shift in education and the need to update teaching skills.



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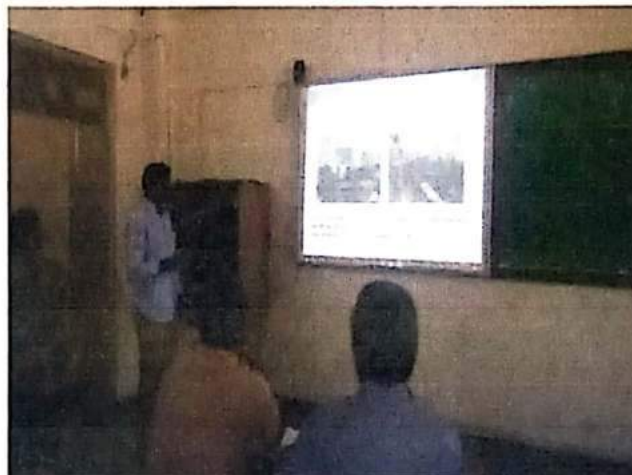
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Workshop-cum-Training in PowerPoint Presentation Techniques for Staff

The teachers and students received training on the strategies to reduce carbon footprint. The participants understood that they should choose the ethics of care and try and repair the damage being done to the environment.



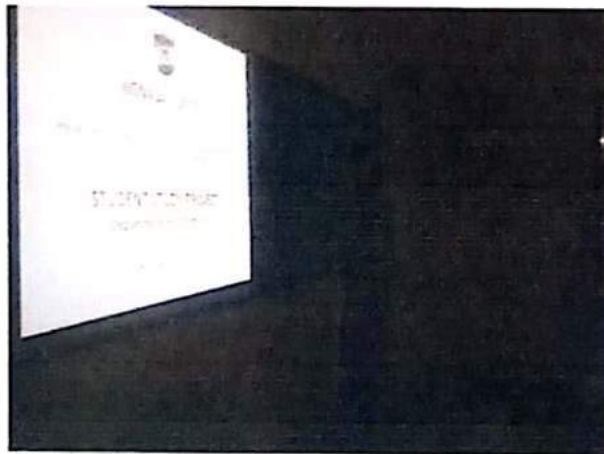
