CIRCULAR

In compliance with the UGC guidelines dated 30.08.2019, this is to inform all the students (B.A., B.Com., B.B.A., and B.Sc.) and the members of the Staff (Teaching and Non-Teaching) that the use of single-use plastics is banned on the college campus and the college is declared to be a 'PLASTIC-FREE CAMPUS.' Accordingly, the following guidelines are to be followed by everyone, without fail:

- a) To ban use of single-use plastics in the institution's premises
- b) To carry out awareness drives and sensitisation workshops on the harmful impacts of single-use plastics.
- c) To mandate all students to avoid bringing non-bio-degradable plastic items to the institutions.
- d) To encourage students to sensitize their respective households about the harmful effects of plastics and make their households 'plastic-free'
- e) To install necessary alternative facilities like water units to avoid the use of plastic water bottles, and encourage the use of alternative solutions like cloth bags, paper bags, etc, instead of plastic bottles, bags, cover, and other goods on campuses.
