Introduction

Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat programme aims to enhance interaction & promote mutual understanding between people of different states/UTs through the concept of state/UT pairing. The programme fosters national integration and unity in Diversity.

Background and Need

India is the land of Pluralism interwoven by diverse languages, cultures, religions and cultures. To bring the spirit of Nationhood and promote mutual understanding among diverse geographical regions and cultures, there is a need to to interconnect the people across all the states. Advances in Technology and Communications can facilitate mutual interaction between different States.

Concept Of EBSB

Against this backdrop, Ekbharat Shrestha Bharat idea was mooted by Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi during the Rashtriya Ekta Divas held on 31st October, 2015, to commemorate the birth anniversary of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel. Hon'ble Prime Minister propounded that cultural diversity is a joy that ought to be celebrated through mutual interaction & reciprocity between people of different States and UTs so that a common spirit of understanding resonates throughout the country. Every State and UT in the country would be paired with another State/UT for a time period, during which they would carry out a structured engagement with one another in the spheres of language, literature, cuisine, festivals, cultural events, tourism etc.

In the pairing of the States, Telangana State was paired with Haryana State.

OBJECTIVES

- 1. To CELEBRATE the Unity in Diversity of our Nation and to maintain and strengthen the fabric of traditionally existing emotional bonds between the people of our Country;
- 2. To PROMOTE the spirit of national integration through a deep and structured engagement between all Indian States and Union Territories through a year-long planned engagement between States;
- 3. To SHOWCASE the rich heritage and culture, customs and traditions of either State for enabling people to understand and appreciate the diversity that is India, thus fostering a sense of common identity.
- 4. TO ESTABLISH long-term engagements and,
- 5. TO CREATE an environment which promotes learning between States by sharing best practices and experiences.


FEBRUARY 19,2020- Essay Writing on Culture of Haryana

JUNE 30,2020- Conducted On line Quiz on Haryana State and Culture:



EBSB CLUB of BJR Government Degree college, Narayanaguda, Hyderabad organized Webinar with paired college in Haryana.



EBSB CLUB organized a Short film programme to make the students aware of agricultural crops and Industrial regions of Haryana .27 students participated in this programme.




Essay Writing (23/09/2020):
