

## **Feedback analysis on Curriculum for the Academic Year 2015-16**

On the basis of the analysis of the Student Feedback Report, the following measures have been initiated.

### **Depth of the course content:**

Based on the feedback analysis obtained during academic year 2015-2016, 126 out of 150 students, i.e., 84 per cent of the student respondents were satisfied with the present curriculum of the courses offered in the college, it was resolved to continue with the curriculum.

### **Applicability/ relevance to real life situations:**

Data was collected and analyzed and it was found that 113 out of 150 i.e., 75 per cent of the students were of the opinion that the present curriculum was helpful in finding employment and 37 out of 150 students i.e. 25 per cent of them thought otherwise, It was resolved to focus on introducing the courses which have a potential to provide employment. Activities with a special focus on employability skills are to be taken up.

### **Learning values:**


A majority of the students i.e., 131 students (87%) felt that the present curriculum was conducive to help them groom themselves to their satisfaction levels. In order to satisfy the remaining i.e., 19 (13%) students, it was decided to introduce capability enhancement and development schemes such as coaching for Competitive Exams, PG Entrance Examinations for various universities, Soft Skills and Personality Development courses.

### **Clarity and relevance:**

75% of the students were satisfied (113 out of 150) as they felt that the present curriculum was addressing the needs of the society. To satisfy the remaining 25% of the students, it was resolved to send proposals to the affiliating university to introduce courses which cater to the present needs of the society and strengthen of course content.


### **Relevance of additional course material:**

138 students out of 150 respondents (92%) were of the opinion that the additional/updated course material provided was beneficial in upgrading their subject knowledge as it incorporates the latest developments in it. However, 12 students i.e., 8% of them felt the need for more content in the subject. Hence, it was resolved to improvise the content with additional inputs.

  
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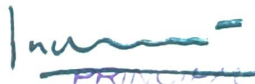

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## Action Taken Report on the Analysis of Feedback on Curriculum (2015-16)

1. As a large number of the students were satisfied with the depth of the course content, its relevance to real life situations, learning values, the clarity and relevance of additional course materials, the curriculum was continued with some additional inputs.
2. On the basis of the feedback analysis, the college will be offering seven certificate courses with emphasis on employability skills.
3. A range of activities with a special focus on employability skills and career development have been planned for the Academic Year 2016-17 based on the Feedback Analysis.
4. Schemes for coaching for Competitive Exams, PG Entrance Examinations for various universities, Soft Skills and Personality Development courses, etc., will be taken up.
5. Extra Course material and additional inputs will be given to the students.

  
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
