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POLICY ON RESEARCH ACTIVITIES

Babu Jagjivan Ram Government Degree College is strongly committed to developing a 'research culture' on campus and therefore focuses on promoting research activities by faculty and students. The Internal Quality Assurance Cell and the Research Committee encourage active involvement on the part of the faculty and students. The college creates an environment for its students to pursue study projects, research and development activities through collaborations with national important institutions with a prime focus of societal benefit.

Policy Statement:

The departments of the college shall have a constant focus in pursuing research mandatorily involving their department students. Every department should have adequate MoUs, collaborations and linkages with academic and scientific bodies. The departments shall actively organize field visits, seminars, workshops, conferences, symposia and ensure that each of these activities should be involved with maximum number of students participating with a great enthusiasm. The departments of the college shall guide their students to publish novel research ideas and innovations in UGC approved Journals and reputed magazines.

When students are associated with research along with regular academic learning, it results in providing a strong impact on their further progression. The rationale of the college research policy is to inculcate research enthusiasm in students and teachers.

Aims:

- To encourage active research involvement of teachers and students and promote a 'research culture'
- To recognize any achievement of teachers through research
- To pursue sustainable research and development with the prime intent of national development
- To provide support and flexibility in administrative processes for teachers who pursue research
- To collaborate with other institutions and research bodies for sharing research facilities

Implementation:

The college implements its research policy by

- Encouraging its students and teachers to involve in field visits to scientific institutions, national level seminars, conferences, workshops, symposia and faculty development programmes.
- Encouraging its stakeholders to publish original and novel research ideas in journals and magazines.
- Creating a comfortable environment for its stakeholders to file patents for their inventions.
- Permitting its teachers to apply for funding from UGC, DST, ICSSR and other national funding organizations to pursue research activities in college.
- Adopting collaborative research with national important academic and scientific institutions of the nation through MoUs and linkages.

The Research Committee of the college constantly monitors the progress of the research activities of all the departments and brings the same to the notice of the Principal.
