SI. No.	Department	Recommendations
1.	Economics	Introduction of Basic Computer skills, Computer Applications, Basic Mathematics to enhance skills in quantitative aspects; additional topics on budgeting system and fiscal policy in Public Finance and International Economics; separate paper for Demography features and Migration
2.	Political Science	Introduction of separate paper on Indian Political thought and Western Political Thought
3.	Public Administration	Introduction of Office Administration
4.	Commerce	Introduction of Leadership and Management Skills in the forthcoming syllabus review
5.	Botany	Introduction of Economic Botany and Biodiversity as GE in the final year to the students of other disciplines as it benefits in understanding our environment and Biodiversity
6.	Zoology	Increase of number of practical hours from 2 to 3 per week and provision of Question bank for practicals.
7.	Chemistry	Introduction of project work for the final year students with the research methods to get a solution to a problem.
8.	Mathematics	Removal of practicals recommended
9.	Physics	Introduction of project work in the final year, as this will be of great benefit in improving experimental learning.
10.	Computer science	Introduction of real-time projects in the III year curriculum to benefit the students
11.	English	Introduction of English in the final year too, as this will be of great benefit to the students.
12.	Telugu	Introduction of separate components on soft skills and personality development; systematic study of linguistics may be introduced as it will enhance the employability skills of the students
13.	Hindi	Introduction of Career Oriented, Soft Skills Training and Student Study Projects for all-round Educational Development of the Students
