Feedback Recommendations (2017-2018)

The feedback from the students, teachers and alumni was collected, analyzed and the following recommendations are sent to the O/o the Registrar, Osmania University for incorporation in future syllabus revision:

SI. No.	Department	Recommendations
1.	Economics	Introduction of Skill Enhancement courses like Basic Computer skills and Computer Applications and also Basic Mathematics to enhance the skills in quantitative aspects; Separate paper for Demography features & Migration
2.	Political Science	Change in 1st year syllabus as most of the topics were covered at the Intermediate level; introduction of Political Thought in the 1st year instead of in 3rd year.
3.	Public	Introduction of Human Resource Audit in Human Resource
	Administration	Management and new topics like rural unrest, urban unrest, Gender budget and green budget.
4.	Commerce	Introduction of Leadership and Management Skills in the forthcoming syllabus review
5.	Botany	Introduction of Tissue culture and Biotechnology as Elective paper in the Final Year to create scope for research and higher education to the students as per the present research industry in the market.
6.	Zoology	Publishing of more books and to introduce more skill enhancement courses
7.	Chemistry	Introduction of project work for the final year students
8.	Mathematics	Advanced learner students have suggested introduction of MOOCS along with real-time projects in the curriculum
9.	Physics	Introduction of project work in the final semester, in order to prepare the students with research and experimental learning.
10.	Computer science	Advanced learner students have suggested introduction of MOOCS along with real-time projects in the curriculum.
11.	English	Introduction of English in the Final Year too, in order to prepare the students for the job market.
12.	Telugu	Introduction of Separate components on soft skills and personality development; Systematic study of linguistics may be introduced as it will enhance the employability skills of the students
13.	Hindi	Introduction of Professional courses like Mass Communication, Functional Hindi and Translation and also introduction of Hindi in the Final year
