### Feedback Recommendations (2019-2020)

After comprehensive analysis of the online feedback from the Stakeholders, the following recommendations are sent to the University to be incorporated in the upcoming syllabus revision:

Sl. No.	Department	Recommendations
1.	Economics	General elective papers like Rural Development and Telangana Economy and additional topics like Micro Economics and Macro Economics are to be introduced in the curriculum. Additional inputs in Public Finance and International Economics, to be included to understand Budgeting system and resource allocations
2.	Political Science	Research Methodology to be introduced as a Skill Enhancement Course
3.	Public Administration	Introduction of Comparative Administrative Systems in USA, Japan and France
4.	Commerce	Introduction of Internship programmes to develop professional aptitude, and provide greater opportunities for real world experience to the students; promotion of Digital or e-Learning which enables the learners to become self-learners
5.	Botany	Introduction of Project work and its evaluation in the Final Year in order to get hands on experience in the research techniques
6.	Zoology	Introduction of Research Methodology & Project Work in VI Semester
7.	Chemistry	Introduction of internship to the B.Sc. final year students to gain research skills
8.	Physics	Advance research projects may be introduced in the final semester projects; peer-learning among students to be encouraged
9.	Computer science	Inclusion of communication skills, professional skills, leadership & management skills and human values as skill enhancement courses during next academic year
10.	English	Introduction of English in the Final Year too, in order to prepare the students for the job market; Personality Development to be introduced.
11.	Telugu	A special course on Personality Development to be introduced for the senior students to prepare them for competitive examinations.
12.	Hindi	Revised curriculum to emphasise on all aspects of Human Values, Professional Ethics, Personality Development and Self-awareness
