Objectives of the Committee:

The main objectives of the committee are as follows:

- To examine the issues and the complaints raised by the students which disturb the learning process of the students.
- To address issues related to student to student relationship, student to teacher relationship and student to non-teaching staff relationship.
- To encourage the students to lodge their grievances, freely and frankly, without any fear.
- To collect and examine the complaints/grievances/suggestions put by the students on academic, administrative, infrastructural and any other matters.
- To encourage students to follow moral and ethical values in order to build good character.

Scope of the Committee:

The Student Grievance Redressal Committee will receive grievances in writing from the students about any of the following matters:

- Academic Matters
- Administrative Matters
- Other Matters- The committee will also examine the grievances related to student welfare which do not come under the above categories

Procedure of the Committee:

The committee will follow the following procedure:

- On obtaining a written grievance/complaint, a meeting of the committee is convened by the Principal to look into the matter.
- If the names of the students are mentioned in the complaint, they will be called for an explanation. Otherwise the committee will conduct an enquiry into the matter.
- If there is any merit in the complaint, the committee will recommend appropriate measures for the redressal of the grievances within three days of receiving the grievance.

Actions of the Committee

• The recommendations made by the committee will be discussed by the staff council and appropriate measures will be initiated to redress the grievance.
